

# TUITION & FEES

## 2017-2018 Upper School Tuition & Fees

### Application Fee

The non-refundable application fee is \$50 per student and is due with a completed Online Application. **After July 15, 2017, the application fee is \$150.** Please go to our website, [www.GreenvilleClassical.com](http://www.GreenvilleClassical.com), and click on the Online Application link under the Admissions tab to begin the application process.

### Enrollment Fee

The non-refundable enrollment fee is \$200. **After August 15 the enrollment fee is \$300.** New families/students, if admission is offered by GCA, the next step is to complete an Online Enrollment. In order to receive the early enrollment discount listed below, the Online Application must be submitted by the calendar deadline listed below, and then the Online Enrollment must be submitted within 10 calendar days of receiving the email invitation to enroll. Returning families/students, in order to receive the early enrollment discount listed below, the Online Enrollment must be submitted by the calendar deadline listed below.

### Tuition

Payments begin August 1. Due dates will be the first of each month beginning in August with the final due date on May 1. Payments are considered late after the tenth of the month when a payment is due. A \$10 late fee will be assessed to all accounts past due on the tenth of each month. A \$35 fee will be charged for a check returned for insufficient funds.

### Other Fees (Some fees listed below may be automatically added to your account)

- Separate minimal fees may be charged for field trips.
- Study Hall: \$200 per study hall
- Textbook rental fees: \$3 - \$50 depending on book
- Lab fees: \$10 - \$50 depending on class
- SLiC (Student Life Committee) fee: \$30 (for class parties at the end of each semester, teacher appreciation, etc.)
- Achievement test fee: \$35 (for grades 7-9)
- Year Book fee: approximately \$15 - \$25 (invoiced late in the school year)
- Course transfer fees: \$50 per course from an accredited school and \$100 per course from a non-accredited school.
- Athletic fees: \$75 per sport for full-time students and \$125 per sport for part-time students.
- Placement testing fee (as required for math and foreign language) : \$25 per test
- Latin Camp: \$65 (required for students taking Latin for the first time)

**Please be advised that all tuition and fees are non-refundable, no exceptions.**

## **Supplies**

Individual student supplies are the responsibility of the parent.

## **Consumable Workbooks and Reading Books**

## **Uniforms**

Parents are responsible for purchasing their children's uniform clothing that complies with the GCA Dress Code.

## **End of Day Pick Up Time**

There is a 10 minute grace period after pick up time. For every 10-minute period past the 10-minute grace period, a \$5 late fee will be assessed.

## **Financial Aid Discounts**

The Board of Greenville Classical Academy does not want a lack of finances to prevent a student (who would otherwise be accepted) from enrolling. GCA uses the services of Independent School Management's Financial Aid for School Tuition (FAST) to assist in assessing a family's eligibility for financial assistance. The cost for this service is \$43. Priority will be given to those families who complete the required online forms by March 31. GCA's Financial Aid Committee will determine eligibility for financial aid discounts.

## **Withdrawal Policy**

If extenuating circumstances demand it, parents will need to complete the withdrawal process to formally withdraw their child from Greenville Classical Academy by contacting the school, completing and submitting the "Greenville Classical Academy Withdrawal Form", attending an Exit Interview, returning all school-owned materials, and paying all charges through the calendar month in which the withdrawal is made. Records can be transferred to another school upon completion of the withdrawal process.
