Applications & Enrollment

APPLICATIONS

Student applications are accepted year-round with a non-refundable \$75 application fee and covers the administrative costs associated with processing your child's application. This includes:

- Reviewing submitted forms and supporting documents
- Recording and tracking applicant information
- Staff time for application evaluation and benchmark assessments
- Initial processing for placement or enrollment consideration
- Application fees are non-refundable and do not guarantee admission

ENROLLMENT

Enrollment fees are \$350 per student (\$250 for K4) and are nonrefundable. This fee reserves a student's place at GCA, offsets the cost of instructional materials, and enables GCA to make financial commitments for the coming year.

- Priority Enrollment (Re-Enrolling Families) – Begins January 5, 2026
- Open Enrollment (New Families) – Begins January 19, 2026
- Summer Enrollment (fee increases by \$100 per student) – June 2, 2026 - July 29, 2026
(Any enrollment during and after this period is at the discretion of the Administration)

Tuition Details

GRAMMAR SCHOOL

K4 - Half Day

- Monday - Friday – \$7,500
- Monday, Wednesday, Friday – \$4,600
- Tuesday, Thursday – \$2,760

K4 Afternoon Enrichment (Optional)

- Full Time (Monday - Friday) – \$5,400
- 3-Day (Monday, Wednesday, Friday) – \$3,240
- 2-Day (Tuesday, Thursday) – \$2,160

Kindergarten (Full-Day) – \$11,500

Grades 1-5 – \$11,500

LOGIC SCHOOL

Grades 6-8 – \$11,500

RHETORIC SCHOOL

Grades 9-12 – \$11,500

Tuition Details

Tuition payments run June–May and may be selected as:

- Monthly plan (12 payments)
- Semester plan (2 payments)
- Annual plan (1 payment) - a 2% discount will be applied if the annual tuition is paid in full.

ESTF Scholarships

ESTF INFORMATION

The Education Scholarship Trust Fund (ESTF) Program is administered by the SC Department of Education and allows qualifying families to apply for a scholarship of \$7,634 per student, per year. Every family at GCA is encouraged to apply. For more information and to begin the application process, please visit sc-estf-program.com.

ESTF APPLICATION TIMELINE

- November 1, 2025 – Applications open for siblings of students currently in the ESTF program.
- January 15, 2026 – Applications open for children of active-duty military and students who attended public school in 2025-26.
- February 9, 2026 – Applications open for families with income at or below 500% of the federal poverty level.

TUITION EXAMPLE WITH ESTF AWARDS:

For a family with three students:

- Annual tuition per student: \$11,500
- Less ESTF Scholarship: -\$7,634
- Net tuition per student: \$3,866
- Total annual tuition for three students: \$11,598

Tuition Partnership Plan

Greenville Classical Academy (GCA) is committed to making classical, Christian education accessible to families from a wide range of financial situations. Instead of automatic tuition discounts, GCA offers the needs-based Tuition Partnership Plan (TPP) to help families for whom tuition would otherwise be out of reach.

ELIGIBILITY

- Families must first apply for the South Carolina Education Scholarship Trust Fund (ESTF).
- ESTF approval does not guarantee TPP; ESTF denial does not disqualify you.

APPLICATION STEPS

1. Apply for ESTF during the state application window.
2. Submit ESTF award or denial documentation to GCA.
3. Apply for TPP through FACTS Grant & Aid (\$40 FACTS fee) <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>
4. Receive TPP award notification via email once ESTF status is confirmed.

AWARD & PAYMENT

- TPP awards are applied to tuition only; all other fees remain the family's responsibility.
- Awards are applied after signing the TPP agreement.
- Families must submit invoices to ClassWallet for scholarship disbursements. Payments are issued in four installments: July 31, September 30, December 31, and February 28

2026-27 Fee Schedule

BOOKS, SUPPLIES, & ADDITIONAL FEES

Families are responsible for providing all required school supplies. Class-specific supply lists will be shared with families prior to the start of the school year. In addition to these personal purchases, some courses require additional supply fees. These fees help cover items that are centrally purchased for the class and will be billed through FACTS after the start of the school year.

Logic School (Grades 6–8)

- \$45 Art Fee – supports required art supplies for all students
- \$25 Music Fee – helps purchase sheet music for each class

Rhetoric School (Grades 9–12)

- \$50 Lab Fee – offsets the cost of additional lab supplies for any Science class
- \$35 Elective Fee – helps purchase supplies for electives and other course-specific materials

STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE

Supports programs and activities that enhance campus life and school community, such as picnics, class parties, House System (Logic & Rhetoric only), and recreational activities (invoiced second semester).

- Grammar – \$45 per student
- Logic & Rhetoric – \$50 per student

SENIOR FEE - AVERAGES \$200-\$300

\$200 per student – Required for anyone participating in the Graduation Ceremony.

This fee will cover:

- Cap & Gown, Stole, and Tassel
- Graduation Ceremony Expenses (speaker, photographer, etc.)
- Senior-only activities throughout the year
- Does not include Senior Trip

ATHLETIC FEE - \$175 PER SPORT

Optional sports for grades 6-12 - invoiced at the beginning of each athletic season.

HOUSE RETREAT (GRADES 6-12) - AVERAGES \$170-\$190

Three-day retreat at the beginning of the school year for all upper school students.
